



LEARNING STYLES

FOR YOUR CHILDREN

Visual

Learners prefer gaining knowledge by seeing. They learn through demonstrations and descriptions by observing their parent's body language and facial expressions. They have strong imaginations and frequently think in pictures.

Auditory

Learners prefer gaining knowledge by listening. They learn by taking part in discussions and talking things through. Verbal instructions can assist in clarifying written instructions or information.

Reading/Writing

Learners prefer gaining knowledge through written words. They take copious amount of notes to help them both process information and have an easier time recalling it later.

Kinesthetic

Learners prefer gaining knowledge by moving and doing. They learn through physical sensations and may struggle to sit still for long periods. A hands-on approach that encourages your child to actively explore the physical world is the most effective way for them to learn.
